TOWN OF LITCHFIELD NOTICE OF SPECIAL TOWN MEETING

Notice is hereby given to the electors of the Town of Litchfield and those qualified taxpayers lawfully entitled to vote in Litchfield Town Meetings pursuant to Section 7-6 of the General Statutes that a Special Town Meeting will be held on Wednesday, August 13th, 2025, at 7 p.m. at the Litchfield Intermediate School, 35 Plumb Hill Road, Litchfield, for the following purposes:

- I. To consider and act on fiscal year 2024-2025 Budget Transfer #9 appropriation of an amount not to exceed a total of \$30,664.00, comprised of: \$28,165.00 from Overtime, \$2,000.00 from Office Equipment, and \$499.00 from Service Contracts, and to transfer those funds to the Litchfield Fire Department, to pay for unexpected repairs to that Department's vehicle fleet.
- II. To consider and act on fiscal year 2025-2026 Budget Transfer #1 appropriation of an amount not to exceed \$31,500.03 from Contingency, and to transfer those funds to the Bantam Fire Department, to pay for the Town's portion of radios used by that Fire Department.
- III. To consider and act on an inter-municipal memorandum of understanding Budget Deficit Mitigation Agreement between Goshen, Litchfield, Morris, and Warren, and Regional School District No. 20, for payment of the remaining fiscal year 2024-2025 budget deficit of Regional School District No. 20, and to authorize the Litchfield First Selectman and Board of Selectmen to take all actions and execute all documents necessary or convenient for said purpose.
- IV. To consider and act on an ordinance Amending Chapter 2, Article II, Division 7 ("Board of Education") of the Code of the Town of Litchfield, which would replace ordinances governing the former Town of Litchfield Board of Education with a new ordinance providing the election, terms, and nominations of Litchfield members of the Regional School District No. 20 Board of Education pursuant to the Regional School District No. 20 Education Plan and Connecticut Public Act 23-208.

Relatives as Parents Program offers support

The Relatives as Parents Program (RAPP) is a support group for grandparents and other relatives who have taken on the role of primary caregiver for related children.

We offer a monthly support group in a warm, nonjudgmental space where participants can share stories, advice and encouragement. We know it is hard to parent a new generation, particularly for seniors. RAPP features guest speakers on a variety of topics, including navigating legal issues, understanding child development, working with school systems and managing stress. All are invited to join this community that fosters friendships and builds a supportive network.

During the month of August we are hosting an open discussion with group members. There will not be a speaker this month. It will be Monday, Aug. 25 at 7 p.m. Dinner is served and babysitting is available. There is no cost to this.

The meetings are held at Brooker Memorial, 157 Litchfield St., Torrington. Brooker Memorial's mission is to prepare children for lifelong success. We understand that supporting children is also supporting the families who raise them. Brooker has received a grant from the Connecticut Community Foundation to support this program, with the express purpose of growing the program to reach more seniors.

Four times a year we offer activities that involve the entire family. Our most recent family event was go karting at R&B Sports in Winsted with pizza and ice cream for all. Previous activities have included family board game night and family trivia in collaboration with Torrington Library.

LVA EMT CLASSES

The Litchfield Ambulance Association is offering a State of CT Office of Emergency Medical Services certified Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) course. The course provides training and associated clinical experience dealing with medical and trauma-related emergencies and prepares the student for employment and/or volunteer service as an EMT. Students must be 16 years of age by the date of graduation. Parental authorization must be granted for all students under the age of 18.

Beginning on 09/02/25, the course will be held Tuesday and Thursday evenings beginning at 6:00 P.M. The anticipated conclusion date is 12/11/25. There are no weekend classes. The course is conducted at the Litchfield Ambulance Training Facility located at 35 Plumb Hill Rd. in Litchfield.

A laptop/tablet and internet access are required. This program combines classroom and on-line learning which eliminates the need for class cancellation due to inclement weather. Students will have access to a video library which contains all classroom lectures, practical exercises, exams, and quizzes. Examinations are computer based in order to prepare the student for the State of CT written exam. Attendance is mandatory, not optional. The video component serves as a supplement in the event of illness, inclement weather, or instructor approved personal matters.

Financial hardship payment plans are addressed on an individual basis.

INDIVIDUALS INTERESTED IN BECOMING MEMBERS OF THE LITCHFIELD AMBULANCE ASSOCIATION:

Financial exemptions/arrangements are available to those individuals who successfully complete the course, obtain their State of CT certification, and fulfill the Association's requirements.


