# JANUARY 24 - ANNUAL TOWN MEETING

## NOTICE OF THE ANNUAL TOWN MEETING TOWN OF LITCHFIELD TO BE HELD ON JANUARY 24, 2026

Notice is hereby given to the electors of the Town of Litchfield and those qualified taxpayers lawfully entitled to vote in Litchfield Town Meetings pursuant to Sec. 7-6 of the General Statutes that the Annual Town Meeting will be commenced on January 24, 2026, at 2:00 p.m. at the Litchfield Intermediate School, 35 Plumb Hill Road, Litchfield, for the following purposes:

- I. As recommended by the Assessor and Board of Selectmen, to consider and act on an ordinance amending Town of Litchfield Code Sec. 14-5, "Additional property tax exemption for veterans and their surviving spouses", updating the income level and extending the filing date for certain tax exemptions for qualifying veterans.
- II. To consider and act on a "*Municipal Electronic Voting Equipment Agreement*" between the Town of Litchfield and the State of Connecticut, and a "*Hardware Maintenance and Software License and Maintenance and Support Services Agreement*" between the Town of Litchfield and Election Systems & Software, LLC, and to authorize the Board of Selectmen and First Selectman to take all actions and execute all documents necessary or convenient for those purposes.
- III. To consider and act on an Agreement for Town Clerk Records Management System and Services between the Town of Litchfield and Info Quick Solutions, Inc., and to authorize the Board of Selectmen, First Selectman, and Town Clerk to execute all documents and take all actions necessary or convenient to carry out that agreement.


- I.** To hear a presentation on restarting town constables in Litchfield, and the operational cost thereof, and to discuss the advisability of such proposal.

# NEWS FROM THE WASTE REDUCTION COMMITTEE



It's the gift-giving and feasting season! In the US it's estimated that consumers will spend a collective \$242 billion on holiday gift shopping—and approximately \$10 billion of those holiday gifts will be unwanted and end up in the landfill.

Food waste increases an extra 25% between Thanksgiving and New Year's. Millions of tons of food gets thrown away, also wasting all the resources that went into producing that food. Food that ends up in the garbage is not only heavy and expensive to dispose of, but produces the greenhouse gas methane in the landfill.

As you plan your festivities, here are some tips to reduce waste:

- Plan meals carefully, including how to use any leftovers
- Compost food waste—at home, or bring for free to the Litchfield Recycling Center
- Gift experiences rather than things
- Choose reusable wrapping or paper alternatives
- Avoid glittery bows, paper and ribbons—these can't be recycled and end up in the landfill
- If you have household items in good condition that you'd like to pass along, bring them to the Recycling Center Swap Shop where they can find a new home
- Items that don't belong in the blue recycling bin might still be recyclable through a program at the Recycling Center—check [here for the list](#).
