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MR. MORISSETTE: This remote public hearing is called to order this Thursday, May 4, 2023, at 6:30 p.m. My name is John Morissette, member and presiding officer of the Connecticut Siting Council. Other members of the Council are Brian Golembiewski, designee for Commissioner Katie Dykes of the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection; Quat Nguyen, designee for Chairman Marissa Paslick Gillett of the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority; and we have Robert Silvestri.

Members of the staff are Melanie
Bachman, executive director and staff attorney;
Robert Mercier, siting analyst; Lisa Fontaine,
fiscal administrative officer.

If you haven't done so already, I ask that everyone please mute their computer audio and telephones now.

This is a continuation of the remote public hearing that began today at 2 p.m. this afternoon. A copy of the prepared agenda is available on the Council's Docket No. 513 webpage, along with the record of this matter, the public hearing notice, instructions for public access to this remote public hearing, and the Council's

Citizens Guide to Siting Council Procedures.

This hearing is held pursuant to the provisions of Title 16 of the Connecticut General Statutes and the Uniform Administrative Procedure Act upon an application from Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a telecommunications facility located on Mason Hill Road in Litchfield, Connecticut. This application was received by the Council on March 1, 2023.

This application is also governed by the Telecommunications Act of 1996, which is administered by the Federal Communications

Commission. This Act prohibits the Council from considering the health effects of radio frequency emissions on human health and wildlife to the extent the emissions from towers are within the federal acceptable safe limits standard, which standard is also followed by the state Department of Public Health.

The Federal Act also prohibits this
Council from discriminating between and amongst
providers of functionally equivalent services.
This means that if one carrier already provides

service for an area, other carriers have a right to compete and provide services in the same area.

The Council's legal notice of the date and time of this remote public hearing was published in the Waterbury Republican-American on March 18, 2023. Upon this Council's request, the applicant erected a sign in the vicinity of the proposed site so as to inform the public of the name of the applicant, the type of facility, the remote public hearing date, and contact information for the Council, including the website and phone number.

This remote public comment session is reserved for the public to make brief statements into the record. The deadline for the public to sign up to speak during this public comment session was Wednesday, May 3, 2023. No member of the public signed up to speak. Please be advised that written comments may be submitted by any person within 30 days of this public hearing.

I request the applicant to make a brief, very brief presentation to the public describing the proposed facility.

MR. BALDWIN: I'm going to ask our

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project engineer, Carlo Centore, to make a brief presentation of the application and its proposal.

MR. MORISSETTE: Thank you, Attorney Baldwin. Please continue.

CARLO CENTORE: Good evening. My name is Carlo Centore with Centek Engineering.

Verizon Wireless is proposing to install a wireless communications facility on Mason Road, just west of Mason Road and east of the Eversource right-of-way. The facility consists of a 110-foot monopole tower structure capable of carrying, accommodating four wireless carriers with Verizon being the carrier at the top of the tower at 105-foot centerline of antennas.

At the base of the tower is what's called the compound area constructed of a gravel pad at a 135-foot access road leading from Mason Road to the tower facility.

This facility sits within a fenced compound capable of carrying the -- accommodating the equipment that Verizon is proposing, along with its generator, propane tank and three additional carriers.

MR. BALDWIN: Thank you, Mr.

Morissette.

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MR. MORISSETTE: Thank you. Very good. Before closing the evidentiary record of this matter, the Connecticut Siting Council announces that briefs and proposed findings of fact may be filed with the Council by any party or intervenor no later than June 3, 2023. The submission of briefs or proposed findings fact are not required by this Council, rather, we leave it to the choice of the parties and intervenors.

Anyone who has not become a party or intervenor but who desires to make his or her views known to the Council may file written statements with the Council within 30 days of the date hereof.

The Council will issue draft findings of fact, and thereafter parties and intervenors may identify errors --
