Public Hearing

2. Application #378 – Karin Nystrom, 11 Headquarters Road - change in roofing material on schoolhouse.

K. Nystrom described the need to replace the wood roof on her residence, the former schoolhouse. New Timberline textured, asphalt shingles are proposed in Apalachin Gray matching the shingles approved for the restored barn structure on the property. With no members of the public present, a motion to close the hearing was made by T. Kyasky, seconded M. Forbes and unanimously carried. Motion to approve the roof replacement as submitted was made by D. Dowden, seconded T. Kyasky and unanimously carried.

3. Application # 379 - Ann McKinney, 37 Sawmill Road - replacement windows on house.

The proposal is for replacement of all windows to match the existing appearance with triple glazed Yankee Home, Enviro Star 1800 windows. The front windows will match existing 12/12 sash, all other matching existing divided light sash. Specifications were submitted along with a photo of the present windows with triple track storms and a photo of Yankee Homes replacement windows installed on a similar historic structure. Windows are to be installed to the exact size of existing, outside color basic brown, screens included. Mullions between glass. With no members of the public present, the hearing was closed on a motion by T. Kyasky, seconded M. Forbes and unanimously carried. Motion to approve the application as presented was made by D. Dowden, seconded T. Kyasky and unanimously carried.
