New Business

Student group from Region 20 will present health and wellness issues evident in their school community.

- Debate club could help inspire civil discourse, help kids become more informed about the things they're passionate or feel strongly about – will want to involve more individuals/organizations, will also need funding
- Looking for \$1,019 to help get them started (LPC to discuss what amount we are able to provide to the students) – Gary also recommended Litchfield Health & Wellness to seek out some of their funding
- Looking to build a community and help foster connection
- LPC to provide \$500, and will also connect them with Debbie Dove/Litchfield Health & Wellness and provide some other suggestions for how to obtain the other half of the funding they need

Review of the film "The Last Drop" shown at the Warner last week. Caroline Wilcox/Ugurlu will present how the film relates to our mission and the potential for its showing in our community

- Film was very moving, showed well how confusing abusive relationships are and how quickly it can snowball

- Some pieces can be removed from the film depending on audience – would want someone from high school/middle school to review and determine specific inclusions/exclusions
- Important to keep in mind that support staff would be desired for those who are triggered by content
- Gary to write to Julie Haggard to see if she will view the film in tandem with support and see if she would be willing to bring into the school

Discuss support for PTO event

- Looking for \$175-200 support from LPC
