 - Vaping Quit Kit
 - Quit Kit handout for students (with info and resources), tobacco tracker, candy, stress ball/fidget, rubber bands, toothpicks, Chapstick
 - Gary thinks we can get something like this in at the high school
 - Can we create a QR code that goes to a downloadable image with resources (info, number to text, etc.)? Kids won't carry around a physical card
 - Does the high school have monitors/TVs that we could add a flyer to the scrolling announcements with the QR code?

 - Origin history family member alcoholism, mental, behavioral, etc.
 - Figure out where the best need for prevention is, problem spots, how we can better help the community and make resources more available
