- IV. To consider and act upon an amendment to the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Litchfield, Chapter 8 "Licenses and Miscellaneous Business Regulations", Article II, "Peddlers, Hawkers and Solicitors".
- V. To consider and act upon an amendment to the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Litchfield, Chapter 12 "Solid Waste Management".

To consider and act upon a ten-year lease of space at the Litchfield Intermediate School from the Town of Litchfield and Litchfield Public Schools to the Litchfield Volunteer Ambulance (LVA), with such space to be used for LVA training and classes for the staff and the public as well as for the Town of Litchfield for a possible future Litchfield Emergency Operations Center.
