Motion: J. Bongiorno put forth a motion to accept the 1/8/26 regular meeting minutes. W. Buckley second and there was no further discussion. All members voted “aye”, K. Honan abstained, and the motion was carried.

Motion: J. Bongiorno put forth a motion to move up agenda item 12, Public Comments for items on the agenda, to item 4.a. W. Buckley seconded and there was no further discussion. All members voted “aye” and the motion carried.

Motion: W. Buckley put forth a motion that for the customer, Prospect Mountain Properties, that they have made an appeal and if they pay the full-face value of the current invoice due, that no further liens or legal actions will be taken if the owner of the property is to receive an adjustment from Aquarion on their previous water bills. If they do get an adjustment, the WPCA will review that. J. Bongiorno seconded, and the following discussion followed. J. Bongiorno commented that we have had not had many customers with this type of problem, and the other customer who had a high-water consumption bill did not have a leak, but had another issue. He stressed that we have to develop a regulation to work through these types of appeals, as we have nothing at this point in time. C. Levesque commented, that before we can forgive anything regarding water leaks and other high charges, we have to develop a process to do this. He assured. P. Dawton that this item would be placed on the next meeting’s agenda and requested that he file a claim with Aquarion for possible relief. There was no further discussion and all members voted “aye” and the motion carried.

Motion: W. Buckley moved to adjourn the meeting at 8:25 pm. J. Bongiorno seconded and there was no further discussion. All members voted “aye,” and the motion was carried.
