Chairman David Wilson read the public hearing notice published in the Republican-American on 5/2/17. The purpose of the Public Hearing is to discuss the proposed increase in the sewer user fee from \$396.00 to \$408.00 per equivalent dwelling unit, EDU, effective July 1, 2017. He said the increase would bring in about \$27,000 annually, and the funds will be used for the operating budget to generate reserve specified by DEEP guidelines – (10% of annual budget annually). The upcoming Torrington plant upgrade could require of us up to \$1.5 million payable over 20 years. The last increase was approved in June, 2012.

Gary Copeland, the only member of the public in attendance, commented on the amount of water going to Torrington.
