RESOLUTION NO. 1: RESOLVED To approve a change in the income threshold in Sherman's ordinance for elderly and disabled residents' tax relief to match the State's threshold (including its cost-of-living increases) plus \$10,000. Motion made by Joel Bruzinski and seconded by Don Lowe. The resolution was explained by Don Lowe and after discussion, CARRIED unanimously by a show of cards.

RESOLUTION NO. 2: RESOLVED To approve adoption of the Municipal Option for Veteran Property Tax Exemptions by expanding the 100 % P&T (Permanent & Totally Disabled) exemption to include (1) exempting up to two acres of the dwelling lot; (2) extending exemptions to certain eligible surviving spouses of qualifying veterans who died before the exemption took effect. Motion made by Joel Bruzinski and seconded by Stan Greenbaum. The resolution was explained by Don Lowe and after discussion, CARRIED unanimously by a show of cards.

RESOLUTION NO. 3: RESOLVED To approve the following changes to the Sherman bidding ordinance that: **A.** purchases totaling \$25,000 or higher need to be procured through our bidding process. **B.** purchases between \$5,000 and \$24,999 are required to have 3 quotes, however, can be sought through a bidding process if deemed necessary. **C.** purchases totaling \$4,999 and less can be procured without 3 quotes; however, as many quotes as necessary can be sought. Motion made by Joel Bruzinski and seconded by Don Lowe. The resolution was explained by Don Lowe and after discussion, CARRIED unanimously by a show of cards.

RESOLUTION NO. 4: RESOLVED To approve an amount not-to-exceed \$112,000 from the capital non-recurring fund to purchase 12 triband portable radios for the Sherman Volunteer Fire department (SVFD). Motion made by Joel Bruzinski and seconded by Don Lowe. The resolution was explained by Robert Accosta Jr. and after discussion, CARRIED unanimously by a show of cards.

RESOLUTION NO. 5: RESOLVED To approve retroactively an emergency expense of \$7,264.66 from the capital non-recurring fund for an A/C condenser and related wiring and hardware on behalf of the SVFD for Charter Hall. Motion made by Joel Bruzinski and seconded by Don Lowe. The resolution was explained by Don Lowe and after discussion, CARRIED unanimously by a show of cards.

RESOLUTION NO. 6: RESOLVED To approve an amount not-to-exceed \$6,000 from the capital non-recurring fund for state-required ballot box cameras for the purchase and installation and set-up of a Verkada 4K IP Network Camera. Motion made by Joel Bruzinski and seconded by Don Lowe. The resolution was explained by Don Lowe and after discussion, CARRIED unanimously by a show of cards.

RESOLUTION NO. 7:

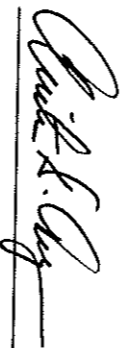
RESOLVED To approve an amount not-to-exceed \$11,000 from the capital non-recurring fund for the repair and restoration of the Veterans Field gazebo roof. Motion made by Joel Bruzinski and seconded by Don Lowe. The resolution was explained by Stan Greenbaum and after discussion, CARRIED unanimously by a show of cards.

RESOLUTION NO. 8:

RESOLVED To approve an amount not-to-exceed \$5,500 from the capital non-recurring fund for the repair and restoration of the Parks and Rec summer office roof. Motion made by Joel Bruzinski and seconded by Stan Greenbaum. The resolution was explained by Don Lowe and after discussion, CARRIED unanimously by a show of cards.
