

Board of Selectmen Special Meeting --August 13, 2026

MINUTES

Present: Don Lowe, Bob Ostrosky, Andrea Maloney, Kris, Fazzone, Kyle Thomson

Meeting was called to order at 10:03 am by First Selectman Don Lowe. Lowe made a motion to “move to Town Meeting an expenditure not-to-exceed \$560,000 from the capital non-recurring fund to resurface Anderson Road.” Ostrosky seconded it. In discussion Ostrosky noted that we had discussed this at length at two different Board of Selectmen meetings and that he was comfortable sending this to Town Meeting. Lowe agreed. Fazzone certified that he reviewed the pricing which includes a 3% contingency. Motion passed unanimously.

Lowe made a motion to “Move to Town Meeting an expenditure not-to-exceed \$33,000 from the capital non-recurring fund to replace the fueling station monitoring system.” Lowe noted that this was for the public works fuel system. Ostrosky added that this also had been discussed at previous BOS meetings and he was comfortable with this motion. Lowe Agreed. Fazzone detailed the need for this replacement. Motion passed unanimously.

Lowe made a motion to “move to Town Meeting an expenditure not-to-exceed \$14,000 for a new sander for a public works truck for winter work.” This had not been discussed at a previous meeting, but Fazzone outlined the need for this sander and emphasized that timing was an issue as it may take several months to take ownership of it and get it installed after purchase. Further discussion by Fazzone and Thomson resulted in the conclusion for some more pricing flexibility, and they asked that the motion be amended to “not-to-exceed \$18,000.” Ostrosky and Lowe agreed and Ostrosky made the motion move to Town Meeting “an expenditure not-to-exceed \$18,000 for a new sander for a public works truck for winter work.” Lowe seconded it. Motion passed unanimously.

A Town Meeting is set for 6pm on August 27, 2026 to be held in Mallory Town Hall.

Meeting was adjourned at 10:14am.
