Notice is hereby given that the location of the polling place is as follows: Sherman Emergency Services Facility, 1 Route 39 North, Sherman, CT.

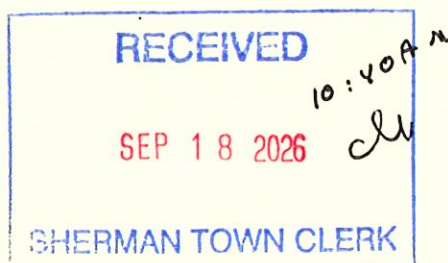
Early voting will take place between Monday, October 19, 2026, and Sunday, November 1, 2026. Early voting hours are 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. every day, except that hours are extended to 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on the last Tuesday and Thursday, October 27 and 29, 2026.

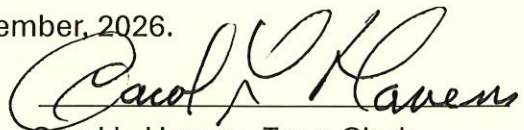
The early voting location is: Mallory Town Hall, 9 Route 39 North, Sherman, CT.
