Meeting Minutes February 11, 2026

Meeting called to order by Chairman Jeremy Weid at 6:03pm.

TVAC Report: Unit One has 3231.8 miles, Unit Two has 46,464.9 miles and E-140 has 27,630.9 miles. Austin Childers has resigned from the Corps. Calls to date totaled 171. E-140 needs a replacement mirror. Part for the plug on Unit One will be here soon. Chains for Unit One are in a labeled grey box in the Communications room. Unit Two will be out of service next Tuesday and will be at

the dealership for a recall repair. The new fly car is being finalized and should be here soon.

Building Report: All the toilets in the building were fixed due to running water. The stove in the kitchen was fixed. The shelter has been opened multiple times.

Vehicle Report: We have chains for both units. E-140 needs new side mirror.

Old Business: Nothing to report at this time.

New Business: Discussion regarding incidents with driving the emergency vehicles. It was suggested that a spotter for backing up will be used at all times except if on an emergency call.
