suction unit for Unit One, also applied for Give Local Grant to purchase portable

TVAC Report: Unit One has 5509.6 miles, Unit Two has 48,857.5 miles and E-140 has 816 miles. Matt and Sharon did the equipment swap for the new fly car. The old E-140 is now part of the town fleet. We have ants in the building, bait stations have been placed and are working. We will hold off on purchasing dehumidifiers while the water problem is being fixed. We have received one new applicant. Applicant is 16 years old; we will pass on this one for now. Calls to date totaled 480.

Building: The roof issue will be addressed after July 1st. The beam issue is all set, the carpet is dry for now. The whole building outside needs new calking.

Vehicle: Old Unit One back at headquarters and will wait until after July 1st to address issues.

Old Business: We attended Rotary Citizen of the Year Banquet honoring Frank Gangloff. Frank is a Lifetime Member of TVAC.
