Meeting Minutes June 10, 2026

Meeting called to order by Chairman Jeremy Weid at 6:03pm

Minutes: A motion was made by Commissioner Molliconi and seconded by Commissioner Flaherty to accept the minutes of May 13, 2026 as read. No discussion on the motion. Motion carried 5/0

Correspondence: Commissioner Campbell E-Mailed First Selectman with the updates to the contract as discussed at the May 13th meeting.

Approval of Bills: Following careful review by the commissioner's a motion was made by Commissioner Molliconi and seconded by Commissioner Campbell to pay the bills as presented. No discussion on the motion. Motion carried 5/0

Treasurer's Report: A motion was made by Commissioner Campbell and seconded by Commissioner Molliconi to accept the treasurer's report as read. No discussion on the motion. Motion carried 5/0

TVAC Report: Unit one has 6,189.8 miles, Unit two has 49,501.5 miles and E-140 has 841 miles. Applicant Jessica DiRe has passed the EMT course and was voted in as a probationary member. Anna Colavecchio will be on a leave of absence for school. New portable suction has been ordered and will be purchased with grant

money. Calls to date totaled 581. The drains have been cleaned and gutters will be cleaned. There have been fewer bugs since the bait stations were placed. Right side scene lights on Unit Two are not working.

Building: The drains were cleaned out in the bays, thanks Justin. Joe talked about a new program through Eversource to install all new LED lights in the building, Eversource will work with the contractor. The total cost would be \$6,700 and can be paid monthly. Joe will bring in the information at the next meeting. Talked about putting this in the new budget to pay the extra amount monthly.

Vehicle: The old Unit One is back and is outside. The town is hiring a new mechanic so we can proceed with the items that need to be fixed.

Old Business: Discussed the Contract between the Town and the Ambulance Corp. The day-to-day operations and duties were discussed. There was a response from the First Selectman from the E-mail Beth had sent him, she will respond.

New Business: Discussion on purchasing new radios with the Fire Dept. A grant can be used for the radios. As it stands now, we can't communicate with other towns. Tri-ban radios can communicate with everyone's portables. Joe will keep us updated.

Adjourn Meeting: A motion was made by Commissioner Molliconi and seconded by Commissioner Whalen to adjourn the meeting at 7:01pm
