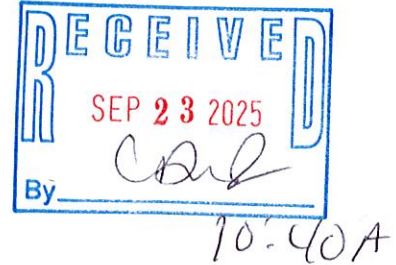


HILLSIDE CEMETERY COMMITTEE  
TOWN OF THOMASTON, CT  
MEETING MINUTES 9/18/2025



The Hillside Cemetery Committee meeting was called to order by Chairman Julie Ingham at 6:05 PM on Thursday, September 18, 2025, at the lunchroom on Level 4, Thomaston Town Hall, 158 Main St.

Brian Davis made a motion to accept the minutes of the August 28, 2025 special meeting. Lynn Wilson seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.

Jamie and Julie saw a demo of the cemetery software program with Tim Scatena. Jamie will start using it to work out the bugs and determine other needs we may have.

The engineering study for dam breach analysis by BL Companies for DEEP is still in process.

The first structure is ready, and Julie is working with Bob Neth to get the sign done. The committee decided to just have the cemetery map on the sign. Al Pfaefflin will be able to get the 2<sup>nd</sup> structure in the ancient cemetery done soon.

Jamie suggested we get a 500-gallon water tank in the spring and place it down near the pond. It will be much easier than replacing all the lines and it will make it easier to pinpoint a problem with leaking water lines.

There will be Ghost Tours on Nov 1 sponsored by the 150<sup>th</sup> committee. Brian is going to paint the Ancient Cemetery sign so we can hang it before then.

Lynn and Julie are going to develop a form/agreement for those purchasing burial plots as we do not have one now. It will contain our rules and regulations.

A motion to adjourn was made at 6:25 PM by Brian Davis and seconded by Lynn Wilson.
