

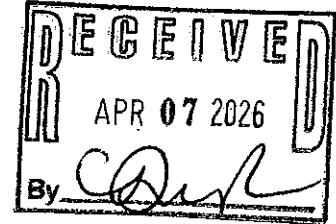
Minutes of the Recreation Commission Regular Meeting 04/06/2026

Old Business

Joe Aniki reports that he spoke to Brice Miller and he has moved on with a different project for his Eagle Scout project.

Joe Aniki reports that he went to the Capital Committee with the request for new fencing at Sanford Field and concrete in the dugouts. The Capital Committee approved the funding for the fence. Joe was concerned because those funds would not be available until July and the fence is laying over on the field. Joe reports that Mario Chiovitti is working on a price to fix the fence that is there. Joe will ask for a breakdown in the quote.
