The Rehabilitation Act covers discrimination against individuals with disabilities by government entities and other organizations that receive federal funding. These include government contractors, private institutions, schools and non profits. Schools must comply with 504 and Title II- Students with disabilities must be provided additional services when deemed necessary, allowed to receive instruction in general classroom when possible, permitted to participate in field trips and activities for which they are otherwise qualified.

If you believe your schools has discriminated against you or your child because of a disability, you may file a complaint with The Office of Civil Rights (DOJ). File complaint until in 180 days of incident. DOJ will review the matter and refer the case to mediation or file a lawsuit on your behalf.
