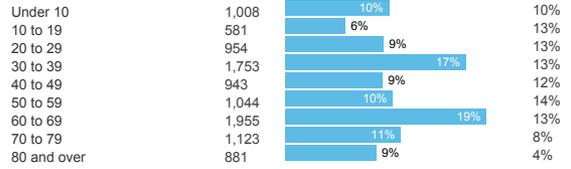

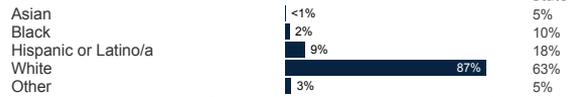

Race and Ethnicity

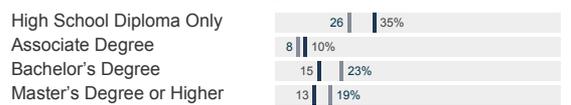
