PRESS RELEASE

The Town Manager, Robert Geiger, of the Town of Winchester, Connecticut announced

that the Town of Winchester, is contemplating a project to rehabilitate the Case Avenue Bridge

over the Mad River. The bridge rehabilitation project would receive federal funds under the

Federal Local Bridge Program administered by the Connecticut Department of Transportation. If

undertaken, the project design would be expected to begin in early 2020, with construction likely

in 2022 or 2023.

Mr. Geiger points out that local and state policies encourages information on such

projects be provided to citizens early and encourages people to raise any concerns to municipal

officials early in the planning process. Persons wanting additional information should contact:

Federal aid would reimburse 80% of the bridge rehabilitation cost, with the remaining

20% paid from municipal funds.

The federal aid for the project was authorized under the Moving Ahead for Progress in

the 21st Century Act (MAP-21) administered by the Federal Highway Administration and the

Connecticut Department of Transportation.
