1. Bid for says "Reclaim to 6"+ AND Reclaim to 6" to incorporate additional aggregate"

a) Are we removing 6" of material and then adding 6" of process aggregate?

No, you will not be removing the existing reclaimed material. Additional aggregate will be added to the existing material, and it will be reclaimed to incorporate it into the base.

b) Are we then mixing the aggregate or just bringing the site to grade with the aggregate?

Yes, the new aggregate will be mixed into the existing road base.

c) If we are, is the town supplying the additional aggregate?

The town will supply the aggregate

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2. Item #4 - Says "Trucking & Additional Aggregate Added to Existing base of various roads"

a) Is this just the cost for trucking because the town is supplying the material?

Correct, Trucking to site, the Town of Winchester will pay the cost of the aggregate
