What you can expect from Winchester Tang Soo Do-

Winchester Tang Soo Do is a Black Belt School affiliated with the Tang Soo Do Masters Alliance centered in Watertown, CT. We teach traditional Tang Soo Do, focusing on mind body and spirit. We encourage an open line of communication between instructors, students and parents to enhance a positive, fun learning environment. Instructors will be present each week with a class plan to ensure that the student will reach his/her goals. An Instructor will be available at the beginning and end of each class to answer any questions you might have.

What Instructors expect from the student-

The student should come to class prepared to participate and learn Martial Arts. Proper respect to Instructors, peers and Dojo etiquette is expected at all times. Students should come to class in uniform, complete with gup belt. Uniforms are mandatory following your first session of classes. Students not in uniform may be excluded from class. Each student will need a mouth guard, sparring gear, and groin protection for males. Any issues should be brought to the Instructor's attention between lessons. If a student is unable to participate in class they should sit quietly off to the side and not interrupt or disturb class. The student is only to use the skills taught by Winchester Tang Soo Do in a defensive manner. It is requested that a parent remain present during class with children under the age of 12 unless prior arrangements have been made with Mr. Negron.

Dojo etiquette-

The student should arrive to class on time. Students will bow upon entering and upon exiting the dojo (where class is held). Proper respect will be shown to all Masters, Black Belts, Instructors, and other students at all times. There is no gum or candy allowed during class. There is no talking in class unless addressed by an Instructor, or the student has a question regarding what is being taught at that time.

Class location and times-

Class will be held at Pearson School in the cafeteria or gymnasium, depending on availability. Students will be notified if there is a need to change the location of class. Please keep your contact information updated for this purpose.

Classes are held Wednesday evenings

- 6:00pm-6:45pm Beginners through Red Belt
- 6:55-7:55 Orange belt with green stripe through Black Belt. Other belts may be invited to attend if the instructor feels it would be beneficial to the student.
- 8:00pm-9:00pm Red belt and above. This class may also be used to prepare for grading or tournaments.
- Extra classes may be offered periodically at Mr. Negron's discretion. There are no make-up classes for classes missed due to school closings.

Tuition-

Tuition is \$25.00 per month and is due the first Wednesday of each month. Payment can be made in cash or check, made payable to Winsted Recreation Department. Unattended classes are not refundable. Winchester Tang Soo Do offers 3 free trial classes with a signed waiver. Tuition will be prorated if you begin midmonth. Unpaid tuition may result in exclusion from class. If you are experiencing financial hardship, please see Mr. Negron.

Club Grading Requirements-

Winchester Tang Soo Do will grade students to a new gup or belt level when the Instructors have determined the student is ready. There is a \$25 fee for grading. Requirements include having a complete uniform with proper trim, 80% attendance to classes with 100% participation during class time. Tuition must be paid up to date and grading fees must be paid prior to the grading or the student may not grade as scheduled.
