Warning for November 3, 2026, State Election

The electors of the Town of Winchester are hereby warned to meet at their respective polling places in said town on Tuesday, November 3, 2026, for the following purposes:

- I. To cast their votes for Governor and Lieutenant Governor, Representative in Congress, State Senator, State Representative, Secretary of the State, Treasurer, Comptroller, Attorney General, Judge of Probate, and Registrar of Voters.
- II. To cast their votes "For" or "Against" Five (5) Charter Revision Questions approved by the Board of Selectmen. The full text of each question is available at the Winchester Town Clerk's office.

Notice is hereby given that the location of the polling places is as follows:

District Number 1	Pearson School, 2 Wetmore Ave. Winsted

Early voting will take place between Monday, October 19, 2026, and Sunday, November 1, 2026. Early voting hours are 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. every day, except that hours are extended to 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on the last Tuesday and Thursday, October 27 and 29, 2026.

The early voting location is located at Winsted Town Hall, 338 Main Street, Winsted CT

Absentee ballots will be counted at the following location: Pearson School 2 Wetmore Ave. Winsted, CT

Voting tabulators will be used. The polls will open at six o'clock in the morning (6:00 a.m.) and remain open until eight o'clock in the evening (8:00 p.m.).
