Sec. 9-46a and you are a citizen of the United States who is at least 18 years of age, who resides outisde the United States, and who - immediately prior to moving outside the United States - was a bona fide resident of a town in this state, who is not registered to vote, and is not voting in any other state or election district of a state or territory or in any territory or possession of the United States; and who has a valid passport or card of identity and registration issued under the authority of the Secretary of State of the Untied States or alternative form of identification.
